Fiscal summary statement:

The project was completed at a cost of \$1,454,120 and a balance transfer to Fund 401 – Water and Sewer Utility Fund in the amount of \$45,880 for total costs of \$1,500,000.

Project summary statement:

This project planned, designed, and constructed stormwater collection and treatment improvements on City-owned land with drainage collection improvements in the catchment area. Tributary catchment included portions of East Marine View Drive, Jackson Park and residential streets and alleys south of Jackson Park.

The improvements removed wet weather flows from the combined sewer system, reducing combined sewer overflows (CSOs) and lessening wet weather volume to the Water Pollution Control Facility on Smith Island.

An ORDINANCE closing a special improvement project entitled “Jackson Park Area Stormwater Separation and Treatment” Fund 336, Program 012, as established by Ordinance No. 3745-20.

WHEREAS,

- A.** The special improvement project entitled “Jackson Park Area Stormwater Separation and Treatment” Fund 336, Program 012, was established to provide for identified improvements.
- B.** The purpose of the project has been accomplished and there are neither outstanding obligations to be paid nor uncollected revenues to be received.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF EVERETT DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. That the special improvement project entitled “Jackson Park Area Stormwater Separation and Treatment” Fund 336, Program 012, as established by Ordinance No. 3745-20 be closed.

Section 2. That the final expenses and revenues for the “Jackson Park Area Stormwater Separation and Treatment” project Fund 336, Program 012 are as follows:

A. Expenses

Design and Construction	\$1,454,120
Remaining Balance Transfer to Fund 401	<u>45,880</u>

B. Source of Funds

Section 3. There are no financial transactions remaining.

Section 4. The City Clerk and the codifiers of this Ordinance are authorized to make necessary corrections to this Ordinance including, but not limited to, the correction of scrivener’s/clerical errors, references, ordinance numbering, section/subsection numbers, and any internal references.

Section 5. The City Council hereby declares that should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or

phrase of this ordinance be declared invalid for any reason, it is the intent of the City Council that it would have passed all portions of this ordinance independent of the elimination of any such portion as may be declared invalid.

Section 6. The enactment of this Ordinance shall not affect any case, proceeding, appeal or other matter currently pending in any court or in any way modify any right or liability, civil or criminal, which may be in existence on the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 7. It is expressly the purpose of this Ordinance to provide for and promote the health, safety and welfare of the general public and not to create or otherwise establish or designate any particular class or group of persons who will or should be especially protected or benefited by the terms of this Ordinance. It is the specific intent of this Ordinance that no provision or any term used in this Ordinance is intended to impose any duty whatsoever upon the City or any of its officers or employees. Nothing contained in this Ordinance is intended nor shall be construed to create or form the basis of any liability on the part of the City, or its officers, employees or agents, for any injury or damage resulting from any action or inaction on the part of the City related in any manner to the enforcement of this Ordinance by its officers, employees or agents.
