Fiscal summary statement:

The funding source for this project will be Fund 401 Water and Sewer Utility Fund. The programmed available funding for design and construction is \$4,200,000.

Project summary statement:

This project will install new water main and abandon in place existing cast iron water mains that are currently undersized, have a high consequence of failure, and recently prone to breaks. The upgrading of these water mains will ensure reliability of water service for existing customers and future development, and that adequate fire flow is provided to these neighborhoods.

The location of the project is

- Providence Regional Medical Center from Wetmore Ave to Oakes Ave. and from 12th ST to 14th ST
- Everett South Marina from Waterfront Place to West Marine View Drive
- Lombard Ave. from 13th to 16th ST
- Rockefeller Ave. from 14th to 16th ST
- Colby Ave. from 10th to 12th ST

Adopt an Ordinance creating a Special Improvement Project entitled "Water Main Replacement "X"" Fund 336, Program 031.



ORDINANCE NO. _____

An ORDINANCE creating a special improvement project entitled “Water Main Replacement “X”” Fund 336, Program 031, to accumulate all costs for the improvement.

WHEREAS,

- A.** The City of Everett is committed to a planned water main infrastructure replacement program.
- B.** The City of Everett has identified the need and obtained funds to construct certain improvements to aging cast iron water mains.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF EVERETT DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. A special improvement project is hereby established as Fund 336, Program 031, entitled “Water Main Replacement “X”” to accumulate all costs for the improvement. Authorization is hereby given to accumulate costs and distribute payments for the improvement project.

Section 2. Authorization is hereby granted for the “Public Works Director” or “City Engineer” under the direction of the Mayor, to assume full and complete responsibility for conducting all tasks and doing all things to accomplish the actions authorized in this ordinance.

Section 3. The sum of \$4,200,000 is hereby appropriated to Fund 336, Program 031, “Water Main Replacement “X”” as follows:

A. Estimated Project Costs	\$4,200,000
B. Source of Funds	
Fund 401 – Water/Sewer Utility Fund	\$ 4,200,000
Total Funds	<u>\$ 4,200,000</u>

Section 4. The City Clerk and the codifiers of this Ordinance are authorized to make necessary corrections to this Ordinance including, but not limited to, the correction of scrivener’s/clerical errors, references, ordinance numbering, section/subsection numbers, and any internal references.

Section 5. The City Council hereby declares that should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or

phrase of this ordinance be declared invalid for any reason, it is the intent of the City Council that it would have passed all portions of this ordinance independent of the elimination of any such portion as may be declared invalid.

Section 6. The enactment of this Ordinance shall not affect any case, proceeding, appeal or other matter currently pending in any court or in any way modify any right or liability, civil or criminal, which may be in existence on the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 7. It is expressly the purpose of this Ordinance to provide for and promote the health, safety and welfare of the general public and not to create or otherwise establish or designate any particular class or group of persons who will or should be especially protected or benefited by the terms of this Ordinance. It is the specific intent of this Ordinance that no provision or any term used in this Ordinance is intended to impose any duty whatsoever upon the City or any of its officers or employees. Nothing contained in this Ordinance is intended nor shall be construed to create or form the basis of any liability on the part of the City, or its officers, employees or agents, for any injury or damage resulting from any action or inaction on the part of the City related in any manner to the enforcement of this Ordinance by its officers, employees or agents.
