Fiscal summary statement:

This amendment makes no changes to expenditures or budget.

Project summary statement:

The City requires specialized technical services to evaluate the cathodic protection and coating systems on our water transmission lines, which consist primarily of steel pipelines. Northwest Corrosion Engineering is a consultant selected from the MSRC roster and is currently contracted to provide these services.

Amendment No. 2 extends the term of the existing Professional Services Agreement between the City and Northwest Corrosion to December 31, 2025.

**AMENDMENT NO. 2
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE CITY OF EVERETT
AND NORTHWEST CORROSION ENGINEERING**



This AMENDMENT NO. 2 is dated for reference purposes _____, 2022. It is by and between the City of Everett, a municipal corporation under the laws of the State of Washington (“City”) and NORTHWEST CORROSION ENGINEERING (“Service Provider”).

RECITALS

A. The City and Service Provider are parties to the Professional Services Agreement dated MARCH 26, 2019 (the “Agreement”).

B. The City and the Service Provider desire to amend the Agreement for the purpose of EXTENDING THE TIME FOR COMPLETION FROM DECEMBER 31, 2022, TO DECEMBER 31, 2025. THE MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE COMPENSATION UNDER THE AGREEMENT IS NOT CHANGED BY THIS AMENDMENT.

AGREEMENT

The City and Service Provider agree as follows:

1. The Agreement is modified so that time of beginning and completion are as follows:

Time of Beginning and Completion of Performance: This Agreement shall commence as of the date of execution of this Agreement and shall be completed by EXTENDING THE TIME FOR COMPLETION FROM DECEMBER 31, 2022, TO DECEMBER 31, 2025.

2. Regardless of the date(s) on which this Amendment is signed by the parties, the parties agree that the Agreement has been continuously in effect since MARCH 29, 2019.
3. This Amendment may be signed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of which, taken together, shall be deemed one and the same document. Execution of this Amendment by a party shall be legally valid and effective by (i) executing a paper copy, (ii) execution by AdobeSign or DocuSign or other e-signature method, or (iii) transmitting an executed copy by email or otherwise in pdf format or other electronically scanned format.
4. All provisions in the Agreement shall remain in effect except as expressly modified by this Amendment.
