The project was completed at a cost of \$2,479,308 and a balance transfer to Fund 401 – Water and Sewer Utility Fund in the amount of \$520,692 for total costs of \$3,000,000.

**Project summary statement:**

The City has three trickling filters which are treatment components within the mechanical portion of the wastewater treatment plant. Two of these large 85’ diameter tanks contain the original treatment media which is at the end of its useful life at close to 30 years old. The third filter was constructed in 2015.

This project replaced the media within both trickling filters over a two-year period with one project occurring Fall of 2020 and the other during Fall of 2021. The treatment media and the aging media support system was replaced along with additional necessary concrete and coating repair work within the interior of the tanks.

**Recommendation (exact action requested of Council):**

Adopt an Ordinance closing a special improvement project entitled “Trickling Filter Media Replacement” Fund 336, Program 008, as established by Ordinance No. 3727-20.

**An ORDINANCE closing a special improvement project entitled “Trickling Filter Media Replacement” Fund 336, Program 008, as established by Ordinance No. 3727-20.**

**WHEREAS,**

- A.** The special improvement project entitled “Trickling Filter Media Replacement” Fund 336, Program 008, was established to provide for identified improvements.
- B.** The purpose of the project has been accomplished and there are neither outstanding obligations to be paid nor uncollected revenues to be received.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF EVERETT DOES ORDAIN:**

**Section 1.** That the special improvement project entitled “Trickling Filter Media Replacement” Fund 336, Program 008, as established by Ordinance No. 3727-20 be closed.

**Section 2.** That the final expenses and revenues for the “Trickling Filter Media Replacement” project Fund 336, Program 008 are as follows:

**A. Expenses**

Design and Construction	\$2,479,308
Remaining Balance Transfer to Fund 401	<u>520,692</u>
Total Expenses	\$3,000,000

**B. Source of Funds**

Fund 401 – Water/Sewer Utility Fund	<u>3,000,000</u>
Total Funds	\$3,000,000

**Section 3.** There are no financial transactions remaining.

**Section 4.** The City Clerk and the codifiers of this Ordinance are authorized to make necessary corrections to this Ordinance including, but not limited to, the correction of scrivener’s/clerical errors, references, ordinance numbering, section/subsection numbers, and any internal references.

**Section 5.** The City Council hereby declares that should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared invalid for any reason, it is the intent of the City Council that it would have passed all portions of this ordinance independent of the elimination of any such portion as

may be declared invalid.

**Section 6.** The enactment of this Ordinance shall not affect any case, proceeding, appeal or other matter currently pending in any court or in any way modify any right or liability, civil or criminal, which may be in existence on the effective date of this Ordinance.

**Section 7.** It is expressly the purpose of this Ordinance to provide for and promote the health, safety and welfare of the general public and not to create or otherwise establish or designate any particular class or group of persons who will or should be especially protected or benefited by the terms of this Ordinance. It is the specific intent of this Ordinance that no provision or any term used in this Ordinance is intended to impose any duty whatsoever upon the City or any of its officers or employees. Nothing contained in this Ordinance is intended nor shall be construed to create or form the basis of any liability on the part of the City, or its officers, employees or agents, for any injury or damage resulting from any action or inaction on the part of the City related in any manner to the enforcement of this Ordinance by its officers, employees or agents.
