**WHEREAS**, August 2020 we celebrate the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the 19<sup>th</sup> Amendment to the US Constitution, giving women in the United States the right to vote;


**AND**, on August 18, 1920, Tennessee became the 36<sup>th</sup> state to ratify the 19<sup>th</sup> Amendment, which was certified on August 26, 1920;

**AND**, the amendment added 26 million women to the pool of eligible voters in time for the 1920 presidential election, the largest single expansion of voting rights in our history,

**Now, Therefore**, I, Cassie Franklin, Mayor of Everett, do proclaim August 18, 2020 as a day of recognition of women's voting rights.
