Update on Powder Mill Gulch Clean up

Boulevard Bluffs neighbors enjoy a lovely walking trail in a ravine called Powder Mill Gulch. A clean-up of groundwater and surface water contamination affecting the gulch has been underway. Representatives from Boeing, the Washington Dept. of Ecology (DOE) and City of Everett will be on hand to discuss the latest update for proposed clean-up of contamination in Powder Mill Gulch. A new proposal by Boeing for ongoing site clean-up will be outlined. Boeing staff will present four options and identify their recommended (preferred) clean up option.

DOE will be considering these four clean up options and wants citizen input. DOE will hold a public comment period later this year. Residents are encouraged to attend this meeting to ask questions, and learn how to participate in the upcoming public comment period.
