If you have an emergency, call 911. For non-emergencies during normal business hours, call the Customer Service Unit at 425-257-7490 to talk with an officer.


## Everett AquaSox Baseball

## Jetty Island Days starts Tuesday, July 5<sup>th</sup> thru Labor Day

The free ferry to Jetty Island, which departs adjacent to the Port of Everett's boat launch at 10<sup>th</sup> Street and West Marine View Drive, operates seven days a week. Donations are accepted and helpful. Ferry reservations must be made at least two business days in advance. For questions on reservations, call the Jetty Island Reservation Line at 425-257-8304. ## What can we do about people who need housing, especially those who are chronically homeless?

### ***City Issues Request for Qualifications to Develop 60-70 Units of Housing***

**Actions:** The City has issued a request for qualifications from service providers and developers to build 60-70 units of low barrier housing within the city. The City has identified a potential property for a future low-barrier supportive housing facility, pending further site analysis and environmental review. The 1.4-acre potential site is located on the east side of Evergreen Way at Pecks Drive.

<http://everettwa.gov/CivicAlerts.aspx?AID=491> The property is part of a larger parcel, currently owned by City of Everett Utilities, that also houses Reservoir 3 and Everett Fire's training facility. The plan is for a developer to design, build and operate the facility to provide supportive services and staffing (24/7) located within the housing itself.

### **Background - Everett's Safe Streets Plan: Housing**

Under the Safe Streets plan, the City is implementing a "Housing First" model to reduce the impact of chronically homeless individuals on the community by providing low-barrier housing coupled with supportive services.

**What is "low-barrier" housing?** Low-barrier housing is permanent supportive housing for homeless men and women with chronic addiction and/or mental health challenges. It is targeted to provide housing and services for individuals who are some of the highest utilizers of City and community resources.
