## **KING 5 features Everett Police's work with Police Assisted Addiction Recovery Initiative**

EVERETT – Everett Police's [Community Outreach and Enforcement Team \(COET\)](#) was recently [praised on Seattle's KING 5](#) for the work they are doing to help addicted individuals in Everett get into long-term, out-of-state treatment.

This is part of the [Police Assisted Addiction and Recovery Initiative \(PAARI\)](#), an organization that partners with national organizations in the healthcare, public and education sectors, among many other agencies. Their end goal is to provide police with the knowledge and resources to help them combat the drug epidemic that so many communities are battling each day.

Everett Police officially partnered with PAARI back in May 2016. Since then, they have successfully sent 16 individuals to long-term treatment with the help of scholarships, when private insurance is unavailable.
