Everett City Council briefed on final land-transfer actions for supportive housing site

EVERETT – Everett City Council was [briefed at their Dec. 13 meeting](#) about the proposed property transfer of the future Safe Streets facility site from the City of Everett to Catholic Housing Services (CHS). The transfer is the final step before ground will be broken at the property off of Evergreen Way at Berkshire Drive, the future home of the 65-unit supportive housing facility.

A final action is expected to be taken at the Jan. 3, 2018 council meeting. With Council's approval, groundbreaking for the site is planned for late January 2018.
