


# Residential Carbon Monoxide Detectors

## Single-Family and Multifamily Dwelling



Placement within Residence Where Bedrooms are in Different Areas


Always install carbon monoxide detectors according to the manufacturer's instructions. Refer to the manual included with the unit.



Carbon monoxide detectors should be installed:  
In every hallway serving sleeping rooms, no more than 10 feet from the door of all sleeping rooms (see Figures 1 & 2);


In each story of a dwelling unit, including basements, but excluding crawl spaces and uninhabitable attics (see Figures 3 & 4).
