Re: Colors of Freedom Parade

On Monday, July 4, streets in downtown Everett will be closed for the Colors of Freedom Parade and other community events. Given your proximity to the closures, we want you to be aware of the traffic plans for the 4th (see map on back).

The parade will take place on Colby and Wetmore avenues, between 11 a.m. and 2 p.m. To accommodate the parade, the following closures and restrictions will be put in place beginning at 6 a.m. and lasting until about 3 p.m. that afternoon:

- Closure of Colby and Wetmore avenues, from 23rd Street to Pacific Avenue
- Closure of Rockefeller, from 23rd to 26th; 24th Street, from Colby to Oakes; 25th Street, from Hoyt to Oakes; and 26th Street, from Wetmore to Rockefeller.
- No on-street parking will be available on closed streets and vehicles parked in private facilities on closed streets will not be allowed to leave during the parade

There will also be additional street closures for other events in downtown Everett:

- California (between Oakes and Wetmore) and Rockefeller (between California and Everett Ave.) will be closed 6 a.m. to 11 a.m. for the YMCA Yankee Doodle Dash
- Wetmore (between Wall and Pacific) will be closed 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. for the Everett Police "Passport to the Police" Open House
- Wetmore (Pacific and 32nd Street) will be closed for the First Baptist Church "Fun in the Sun" Street Fair, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Signs will be posted July 1 to advise motorists of the closures. On July 4, vehicles will not be allowed to enter or leave the closed areas. If you live or work in the area and plan to use your vehicle on the 4th, please make other parking arrangements.
