Re: Colors of Freedom Festival

On Monday, July 4, the City of Everett will host the Colors of Freedom Festival at Legion Memorial Park. Given your proximity to the park, we want you to be aware of the traffic plans for the upcoming event (see map on back).

Like previous years, the festival will take place from 1 p.m. to 11 p.m. To help manage traffic flow, the following closures and restrictions will be put in place:

- Legion Park overlook parking lot on the west side of Alverson Boulevard will be closed, from July 3 to July 5, for event set-up and take-down.
- Alverson Boulevard will be closed at 6 a.m., July 4, from W. Marine View Drive to 2nd Street (the south end of the park).
- Alverson Boulevard, from 2nd Street to Rockefeller Avenue, will be open for local residents, but closed to other traffic beginning at 6 a.m., July 4.

To reduce traffic, Everett Transit will provide free transportation to and from Legion Park for the event. Like last year, the pick-up/drop-off location will be at the intersection of W Marine View Drive and Alverson Boulevard.

Once the fireworks begin at about 10:20 p.m., we ask local residents to refrain from driving on the closed streets until midnight. This will allow spectators to safely exit the area and give city crews time to remove traffic cones and barriers.
