Nighttime noise variance

Dear Mr. Haws:

Noise from temporary construction sites is allowed 7 am – 10 pm on weekdays, 8 am – 6 pm on weekends and state holidays. The City grants a limited variance from the noise ordinance, EMC 20.08, for the Water Main Q replacement project. In order to minimize traffic impacts and re-open Broadway Avenue by 3 pm daily, work can begin at 6 am on weekdays.

This variance allows for a 1-hour early start during the construction window of October 17, 2016 – January 31, 2017. In an effort to minimize impacts on residential properties, the following mitigation measures shall be in effect:

- Back-up alarms shall be directional broad band type alarms
- Trucks performing export haul shall have well maintained bed liners
- Jackhammer, vacuum excavation and saw cutting will not be done before 7 am weekdays
- No variance is granted for construction work on Saturdays, Sundays or state-recognized holidays.
- Notification of affected residential property owners of this variance by mail or by hand delivery. Complaints about violation of the conditions of the variance can be directed to the noise administrator at 425-257-8775. A copy of this letter will suffice as notification.

A copy of this variance must be on-site during construction hours. Should you wish to extend this variance please submit a renewal request prior to expiration of this variance.
