Rucker Avenue--41st Street to West Marine View Drive

Dear Mr. Gammell:

Noise from temporary construction sites is allowed 7 am – 10 pm on weekdays, 8 am – 6 pm on weekends and state holidays. The City grants a limited variance from the noise ordinance, EMC 20.08, for the Freight Corridor Improvements project. In order to minimize traffic impacts, night time construction work will be allowed at the following intersections:

- West Marine View Drive & Pacific Avenue
- Grand Avenue & Pacific Avenue
- Rucker Avenue & Pacific Avenue
- 35th Street & Rucker Avenue

This variance allows for 20 days of night time work during the construction window of October 31– December 12, 2016. In an effort to minimize impacts on residential properties, the following mitigation measures shall be in effect:

- Back-up alarms shall be directional broad band type alarms
- Trucks performing export haul shall have well maintained bed liners
- Dump trucks will have anti-slam tailgates or an enforced “no slam” policy on site
- Jackhammer, vacuum excavation and saw cutting will be done during normal construction hours or as early as possible during the variance period when feasible.
- No variance is granted for construction work on Saturdays, Sundays or state-recognized holidays.
- Notification of affected residential property owners of this variance by mail or by hand delivery. Complaints about violation of the conditions of the variance can be directed to the noise administrator at 425-257-8775. A copy of this letter will suffice as notification.

A copy of this variance must be on-site during construction hours. Should you wish to extend this variance please submit a renewal request prior to expiration of this variance.
