Notice of Planning Commission Public Workshop

Addition to Snohomish County Courthouse

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Everett Planning Commission will hold a public workshop on Tuesday, August 15, 2017, at their regular meeting, which begins at 6:30 pm, in the City Council Chambers located in the William E. Moore Historic City Hall, 2930 Wetmore Avenue.

The purpose of the public workshop is to consider plans for an addition to the Snohomish County Courthouse, located at 3000 Rockefeller Avenue. The Snohomish County campus is the subject of a 2002 development agreement between the City and County, under the Planned Development Overlay (PDO) Zone. The Everett Municipal Code requires that changes to a PDO master plan that do not qualify as minor revisions be approved through the Planning Commission and City Council review processes. The proposed changes have been determined as major amendments.

The Planning Commission will not be making a decision at the August 15, 2017 public workshop. The public is welcome to attend and provide comments about the proposed amendment to the master plan.
