Code Amendment
Electric Fences**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Everett City Council will hold a **public hearing on Wednesday, April 18, 2018**, at their regular meeting which starts at 6:30 pm in the City Council Chambers, located in the William E. Moore Historic City Hall, 3002 Wetmore Avenue.

The purpose of the public hearing is to consider the recommendation of the Planning Commission to amend the Zoning Code and Building Code regulations for electric fences. The Planning Commission has recommended that electric fences be allowed in commercial and industrial zones for security purposes using Review Process II that requires notice to surrounding property owners. Under the City's existing regulations, electric fences are prohibited except in the agricultural zone.

The public is welcome to attend and provide testimony. There will be a City Council **briefing on the proposed ordinance on Wednesday, April 4, 2018**, at the regular City Council meeting starting at 6:30 pm in the City Council Chambers.
