## **2017 bike master plan update**

This 2017 update to the 2011 City of Everett Bike Masterplan is full of information about projects to connect and improve existing facilities. A concise listing of the project is shown below.

### Coming soon

- Grand Avenue Pedestrian Bridge (2019)
- Alverson Blvd. & WMVD Bike and Pedestrian Safety (rectangular rapid flashing beacon (RRFB)) crossing
- 41<sup>st</sup> St & Grand Ave Bike and Pedestrian Safety (rectangular rapid flashing beacon (RRFB)) crossing

### Completed

- 112<sup>th</sup> Street Corridor Completion (2011-E/W bike lanes from Airport Road to Bothell-Everett Highway)
- Interurban Trail Bollard Replacement (2013)
- 7<sup>th</sup> Ave SE bike lanes (Everett Mall Way to 112<sup>th</sup> Street SE)
- Holly Drive SW bike lanes
- 41<sup>st</sup> Street side path connection (Interurban to Lowell, Riverfront, and Broadway)
- Hoyt signed route (19<sup>th</sup> Street to Everett Ave)
- Broadway Bridge replacement (Bike signal at Broadway & California, connects CBD to US-2, right turn only for motor vehicles)
- Smith Ave. 41st to Everett Station (Riverfront Trail Extension – shared use path, SB Climbing Lane on the Connector, Roadway Sharrows, Sidewalks & Sidepath)
- WMVD Pedestrian & Bike Project (Shared Use Path Improvements, Waterfront Access)
- East Everett Walkway to EMVD Pedestrian & Bike Link (Shared Use Path Connection from E. Grand to EMVD, Key link below I-5 linking elements of the Mill Town Trail)
- North Everett Pedestrian & Bicycle Safety (Safety funding, multiple safety project elements, bicycle detection at Colby & 19th bike lanes, 36th Street improvements-Broadway to Smith)
- Hawthorne Elementary Safe Routes (bike improvements, sidewalk & crossing improvements, traffic calming)
- Hoyt CBD Streetscape with Bike Lanes

### Planned (funded)

- Hoyt Streetscape Phase 2 (Wall to Pacific)
- Pacific & Hoyt to Interurban Trail bike safety project
- California Street Bike and Pedestrian Corridor (Broadway to US-2), WMVC to Broadway
- 19th Street bike lane improvements and signal detection
