## Notice of Funding Availability-2019 Everett Human Needs Grants

Each year, the City allocates \$3 per capita for grants to non-profit human service organizations providing services to our most vulnerable City of Everett residents. The 2019 funding round includes \$333,600 to be available. An additional \$1 per capita has been included for Safe Streets Plan programs and activities for total amount of \$111,200.

Priorities for 2019 Human Needs Grant funding round are based on basic human needs in the community. These funds are available to non-profit agencies providing qualified programs inside the City of Everett. Basic needs may include

- **Shelter**
- **Housing**
- **Food**
- **Health services**
- **Mental health and addiction treatment**
- **Employment, and/or prevention services**

Qualified programs and/or services must benefit our most vulnerable residents including:

- **Youth**
- **Seniors**
- **Persons living with disabilities**
- **Persons experiencing homelessness or extreme poverty.**

Additional Human Needs Grant funding has been made available in 2019 to target Safe Streets Programs and will prioritize programs that continue and maintain the mission of supporting pathways towards stability including shelter, housing, employment, diversion and services to homeless individuals.

A portion of the Safe Streets programs and activities grant funds are designated for a safe parking pilot program and CHART Case Management.

**Applications Available:** Application packets for 2019 Everett Human Needs Grants are now available from the City of Everett Community, Planning and Economic Development Department. The Committee will review applications and make funding recommendations on January 23, 2019 in the 8<sup>th</sup> Floor Hearing Room located at 2930 Wetmore Avenue, Everett, WA 98201
