Langus Riverfront trail closure planned July 8 – Aug. 8

Everett Public Works performing dike maintenance

EVERETT, WA – A portion of the [Langus Riverfront Trail](#) on the southwest riverbank on Smith Island will be completely closed to the public for dike maintenance starting July 8. The closure is expected to last until Aug. 8.

Dikes on Smith Island keep floodwaters from the Snohomish River and Union Slough at bay, protecting Everett's water pollution control facility and providing a recreational amenity for the public. During this project, crews will stabilize the surface of the trail, to prevent sloughing and to meet ADA requirements.
