

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS SERVICE PARKING

1. *What is the difference between a Delivery Parking Permit and a Commercial Vehicle Service Parking Permit?*

- A Delivery Parking Permit is for persons conducting loading, unloading, or delivery of tangible goods on more than a one-time basis to businesses or residences located within the Central Business District. The permit **exempts** permitted vehicles from prohibitions on reparking in the Central Business District
- A Commercial Vehicle Service Parking Permit is for persons rendering a service or repair on more than a one-time basis, such as contractors, painters, plumbers, carpenters, electricians, or other service providers, to buildings, equipment or utilities located within the Central Business District. The permit **exempts** permitted commercial vehicles from time limit restrictions and prohibitions against reparking while actively rendering service to an adjacent property or tenant.

2. *What information is required to apply for a Delivery Parking Permit?*

- Vehicle license plate number
- Applicant's or employer's business license number and issuing municipality
- Stated necessity for the permit

3. *What information is required to apply for a Commercial Vehicle Service Parking Permit?*

- Commercial vehicle license plate number
- City of Everett business license number
- Stated necessity for permit
- How the use complies with the criteria for commercial vehicles (one or more of the following criteria)
 - Clearly displayed company name and/or logo on vehicle
 - Equipment or tools necessary for the provision of service are integral to the vehicle, e.g., air compressor, bumper-mounted vice, etc.
 - Minimum Gross Vehicle Weight of 8,000 pounds

4. *What if I need to make a service call to a residence?*

- Registered Commercial Service Vehicle permit holders are **exempt** from holding a residential parking zone permit and
- **Exempt** from the implemented Residential Parking Zone (RPZ) time limits and RPZ no-parking restrictions.

5. *How long is my Delivery Parking permit or Commercial Vehicle Service Parking Permit valid?*

- Permits are valid for a period of one year from January 1st (or any portion of the year from the date issued) to the following December 31st.
- Each vehicle requires a separate permit with no annual maximum fee to a single business.

6. *What if I have unpaid parking tickets?*

- The City Clerk may deny an application for a Delivery Parking Permit or Commercial Vehicle Service Parking Permit if the applicant has unpaid parking citations.
