Sidewalks are the responsibility of the adjacent property owners and occupants.

If you own, work or live on a property with an adjacent sidewalk, [it's yours to keep clear of snow](#). If you need assistance clearing your sidewalk, private companies provide this service, or your neighbors may be able to help.

What happens if I don't clear my sidewalk?

Everett's sidewalk maintenance compliance focuses on educating the public on their responsibility to clear the sidewalk. Failure to maintain a sidewalk will result in a notification from the City.

How can I help?

Spread the word that it's everyone's responsibility to keep their sidewalks clear and safe to use. Look around to see if a neighbor could use help. Making our sidewalks safe is a community effort.
