This Court finds that there is a public health emergency caused by the spread of Coronavirus/COVID-19 in all Washington counties, including Snohomish County, and that an order to suspend certain court rules is needed to promote the safety of court employees, court participants and the general public; and


WHEREAS, on March 4, 2020, the Chief Justice issued Order No. 25700-B-602 in response to this public health emergency that affects the operation of trial courts in Washington, granting emergency authority to this court to adopt, modify, and suspend court rules and orders, as warranted to address this emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The Jury Term of March 23-24 is cancelled. Jurors will not be requested for this term. This order shall constitute good cause for the court to reset any cases set for jury trial in this term and any such continuance will be an excluded period, pursuant to CrRLJ 3.3 (e)(8).
2. All Infractions calendars between March 16 and April 30, 2020, are cancelled and cases will be reset to calendars in May or later. The time for hearing periods set out

1 in IRLJ 2.6 are suspended and all continuances pursuant to this order shall be
2 excluded periods.
