**Description of proposal:** Amend Everett Municipal Code 19.08.120, Home Occupations.  
(REVV21-001)

The proposed action is to update the home occupation code to reflect new types of businesses and ensure compatibility with residential uses.

The City of Everett has determined that the proposed action will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c) based on review of an environmental checklist for the non-project action.

This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340(2) and the **comment period will end on June 8, 2021.**
