



**Notice of Public Hearing and
DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

Comprehensive Plan Amendments and Parks Impact Fee

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Everett Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on the proposed comprehensive plan amendments and establishing a parks impact fee as part of the annual docket at **6:30 PM on Tuesday, Sept. 21, 2021.**

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the City of Everett SEPA Responsible Official, after review of an environmental checklist and other information regarding this proposed action, issued a Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS). Issuance of the DNS is a determination that there will be no probable significant adverse environmental impacts from the proposal and that a detailed Environmental Impact Statement is not required.

Proposal: Proposed amendments to Parks and Recreation Element and Capital Facilities and Utilities Element includes updated inventory and community profile, parks level of service, capital facility program, policies that support the level of service. The updated goals and policies will align with the pending Parks, Recreation, and Open Space Plan. A Parks Impact fee is also proposed.
