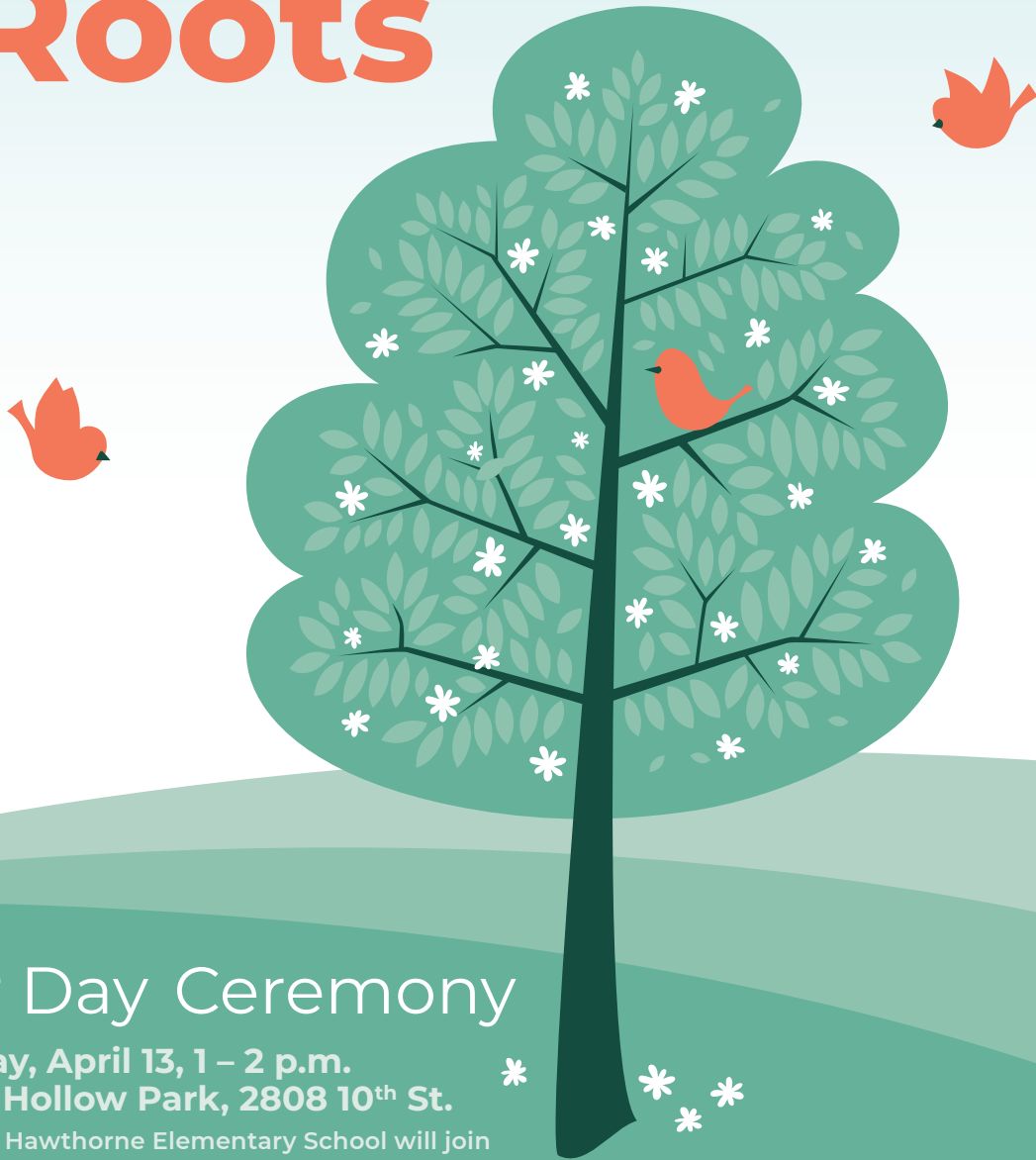


# Rings & Roots
