RE: Hot Mix Asphalt Overlay 2022 Project Night Noise Variance

Gael:

The City grants a variance to the noise ordinance, EMC 20.08, for the 2021 HMA Overlay work. In order to minimize traffic impacts during commute hours, this work must be performed at night. The variance allows nighttime work at the following locations:

The variance allows for up to 30 days of nighttime work between 10 pm and 7 am at each location during the construction window of May 1– October 30, 2022. This variance applies to the contractor and subcontractors selected by the City of Everett for this project. To minimize impacts on residential and business properties, the following mitigation measures shall be in effect:

- Back-up alarms shall be directional broad band type alarms
- Trucks performing export haul shall have well maintained bed liners
- No construction work will be allowed between 6 pm and 8 am on Saturdays, Sundays or federally recognized holidays
