



**NOTICE OF PLANNING COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING
AND DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Everett **Planning Commission will hold a public hearing at 6:30 pm on Tuesday, July 19, 2022** on the proposed code amendments. The hybrid meeting will be held in the city council chambers located at 3002 Wetmore Ave., Everett. The City of Everett SEPA Responsible Official, after review of an environmental checklist, has issued a Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS) on the proposed action. Issuance of the DNS is a determination that there will be no probable significant adverse environmental impacts from the proposal and that an environmental impact statement is not required for this non-project action.

Proposed Action: Amend Everett Municipal Code sections: 15.02.070 Review Process II- Planning director review; 15.02.140 Temporary outdoor encampments, safe parking areas or tiny home communities; 19.04.050 Use definitions, residential; 19.05.068 Temporary uses; 19.05.080 Table 5-1 residential use table; 19.05.090 Table 5-2 commercial use table; 19.08.200 Group housing, temporary shelter; 19.34.020 Table 34-1 Off-street parking spaces required.
