

**CITY OF EVERETT CITIZENS' COMMISSION
ON SALARIES OF ELECTED OFFICIALS
SALARY SCHEDULE FOR 2016 - 2017**

The City of Everett Citizens' Commission on Salaries of Elected Officials pursuant to Section 2.8 of the City of Everett Charter hereby adopts the following salary schedule for elected officials:

1. **Mayor:** The Mayor's salary for 2015 is \$13,919 per month through December 31, 2015. Effective January 1, 2016, the Mayor's salary for 2016 will be determined by increasing the Mayor's salary for 2015 by the same percentage of cost of living adjustment that the appointive, non-represented City employees receive for 2016.

Effective January 1, 2017, the Mayor's salary for 2017 will be determined by increasing the Mayor's salary for 2016 by the same percentage of cost of living adjustment that the appointive, non-represented City employees receive for 2017.

2. **City Council Members:** The City Council members' salary for 2015 is \$2,247 per month per Council member through December 31, 2015. Effective January 1, 2016, the City Council members' salary for 2016 will be \$2,292 per month per Council member.

Effective January 1, 2017, the City Council members' salary for 2017 will be \$2,338 per month per Council member.

3. **City Council President/Mayor Pro Tem:** The salary for the City Council member designated as City Council President/Mayor Pro Tem is and shall be thirty percent (30%) in addition to his/her salary as a City Council member.


4. **Municipal Court Judges:** The salary for a full-time Everett Municipal Court Judge shall be equal to that of a Washington State District Court Judge (currently \$148,881 per year) and shall automatically be adjusted at such times and with the same effective dates as any adjustment to the salary of Washington State District Court Judges.

5. **Benefits:** All benefits for the Mayor, City Council members, and Municipal Court Judges are provided for outside the scope of this schedule.
