



PLANNING COMMISSION RESOLUTION NO. 22-01
A Resolution Recommending that the City Council Adopt the
Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for 2023 to 2028

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission finds the following:

1. RCW 35.77.010 requires that the legislative body of each city and town shall prepare and adopt a "Comprehensive Transportation Program" for the ensuing six calendar years to serve as a guide in carrying out a coordinated transportation facility construction program, and that said legislative body shall annually thereafter review, amend as necessary, and readopt said Comprehensive Transportation Program; and
2. In compliance with RCW 35.77.010 there exists such a Comprehensive Transportation Program (known as the Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program or TIP) for the City of Everett that identifies various types of transportation improvements needed, and estimated costs; and
3. The Planning Commission of the City of Everett has reviewed the 2023-2028 update of the Six-Year TIP and finds that:
 - a) The adoption of the update to the City of Everett Transportation Improvement Program enables the City to apply for and receive various state and federal funds to implement the projects in the program; and
 - b) The proposed program is consistent with and implements the City of Everett Comprehensive Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PLANNING COMMISSION RESOLVES THE FOLLOWING:

The Planning Commission recommends that the City Council adopt the 2023-2028 annual update of the Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully set forth.
