No injuries in early morning south Everett commercial fire

EVERETT, WA – Early this morning, just before 3:30 a.m., an alert security guard called 911 to report smoke coming from the roof of a strip mall in the 10100 block of Evergreen Way. There were no injuries.

Fire crews arrived to find a working fire in the attic space above Toyama Sushi restaurant. As firefighters worked to extinguish the fire, they discovered it had extended to the neighboring business, Cricket Wireless. Crews prevented the fire from spreading further into Cricket Wireless and stopped the extension of fire into any of the adjoining businesses. Both businesses suffered fire, smoke and water damage, with adjoining businesses impacted by smoke.

Mutual aid was provided by South County Fire.

A fire investigator was called to the scene and believes the fire started in the attic area. The origin of the fire is under investigation.
