RE: 2023 Federal Overlay – Noise Variance

Dear Mr. Kangas:

The City grants a variance to the noise ordinance, EMC 20.08, for the 2023 Federal Overlay work. In order to minimize traffic impacts during commute hours, this work must be performed at night. The variance allows nighttime work at the following locations:

Street Name	Cross Street Limits	Variance Type
I-5 NB shoulder & exit ramps	to Broadway Ave & 40th St	Night Work Allowed
Broadway Avenue	41st St to 35th St	Night Work Allowed
Broadway Avenue	35th St to Hewitt	1 hour Early Start
Broadway Avenue	35th St to Hewitt	Night Work Allowed for Pavement Marking

The variance allows for up to 33 days of nighttime work between 10 pm and 7 am at each location during the construction window of May 1 – October 31, 2023. This variance applies to the contractor and subcontractors selected by the City of Everett for this project. To minimize impacts on residential and business properties, the following mitigation measures shall be in effect:

- Back-up alarms shall be directional broad band type alarms
- Trucks performing export haul shall have well maintained bed liners
- No construction work will be allowed between 6 pm and 8 am on Saturdays, Sundays or federally-recognized holidays
