Firefighters extinguish two-alarm house fire

EVERETT, WA – At 10:00 a.m. this morning, 9-1-1 received several calls reporting a house fire in the 11200 block of E. Ibberson Dr., which is located in the Silver Lake neighborhood on the north side of the lake. Neighbors reported seeing heavy black smoke coming from a home.

Firefighters arrived to find a working house fire with flames and smoke showing. Crews took an offensive attack on the fire. The fire response was upgraded to a second alarm as crews worked to contain and extinguish the fire. Firefighters took action to prevent the fire from spreading to neighboring homes and quickly contained and extinguished it after approximately 20 minutes. Once the fire was tapped, crews focused on hot spots and clean up. The south side of the house sustained heavy fire damage, which included a second-story deck. At least two vehicles on the property were also damaged.

Mutual aid was provided by South County Fire.

The American Red Cross was called to assist two displaced residents - one adult and one child.

The cause and origin of the fire are under investigation. At this time, the assessed dollar amount of damage has not been determined.
