Everett Transit seeks input on Vision 2044 long-range plan

The public is invited to attend an open house or take the online survey by Dec. 31

EVERETT, WA – Everett Transit is in the midst of planning for its next 20 years through the Vision 2044 long-range planning process and is seeking input from the community to learn about transportation needs and priorities. They will host two community open houses to provide an opportunity to learn more and provide feedback and they also launched an online survey.

Everett is growing – by as much as 60% in the next 20 years. Everett Transit is planning now for the future – and looking for community input to help shape plans and priorities for years to come.

“As more people call Everett home—we need a transit system that helps riders get to the places they need to go—whether that’s to work, connecting to the regional Link light rail system or the neighborhood grocery store,” said Tom Hingson, director of transportation services at Everett Transit. “We want to hear from you as we plan for the next 20 years.”

The open houses will feature display boards that explain the planning process and will include some of the feedback received from the community thus far.
