Use the attached dye kit to detect a toilet leak.

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Remove the tank cover, drop ONE dye strip or tab into the toilet tank.
- 2. DO NOT FLUSH.
- 3. Wait 20 minutes.
- 4. If the water in the bowl remains clear, no leaks have been detected.

If the water in the bowl turns blue, there is a leak in the tank. The repair may be a simple one. Take steps to repair the leak yourself or contact a licensed plumber.
